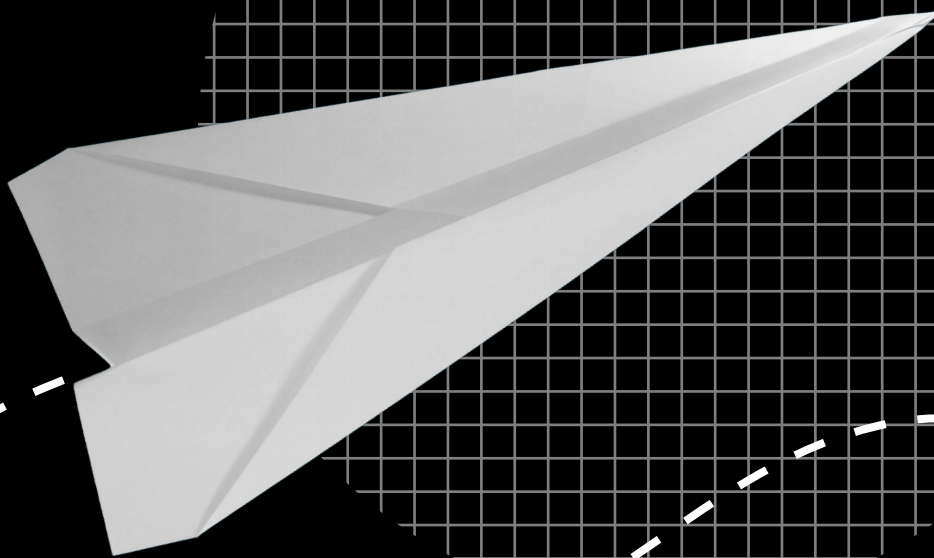

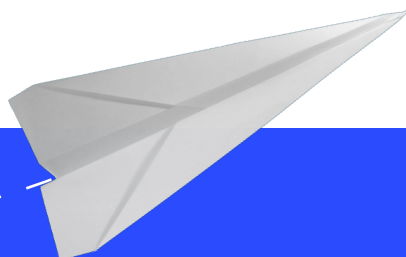

In 2023, [63% of accounting firms](#) identified workflow management as their primary challenge. Workflow chaos stems from a lack of structure and processes.

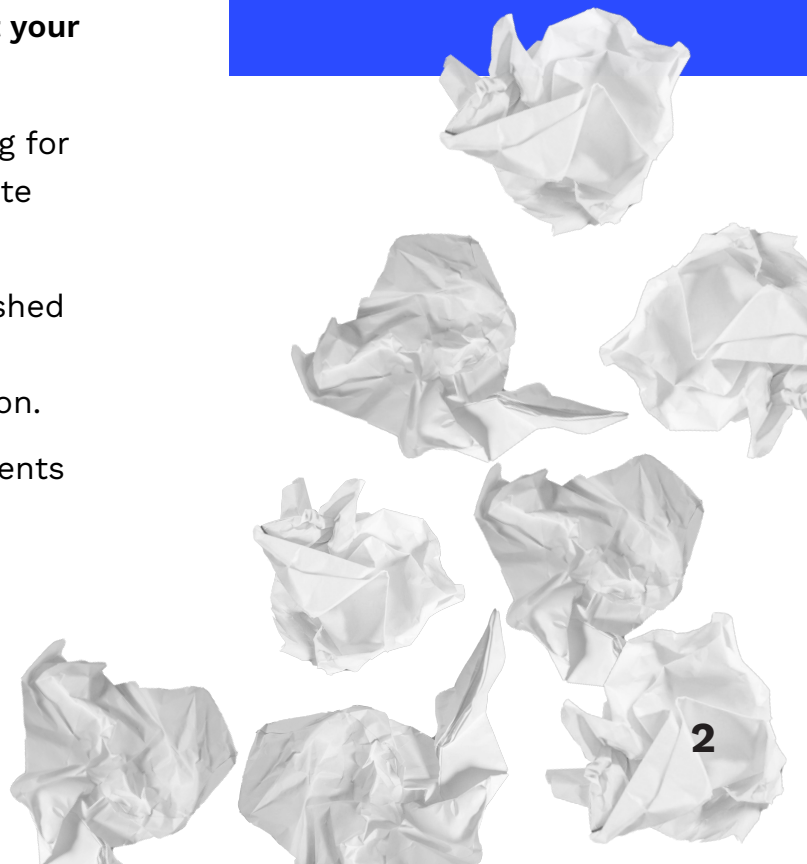

Uncertainty grows, and they wonder if their accountant has everything they need. This lack of communication leads to frustration and mistrust.

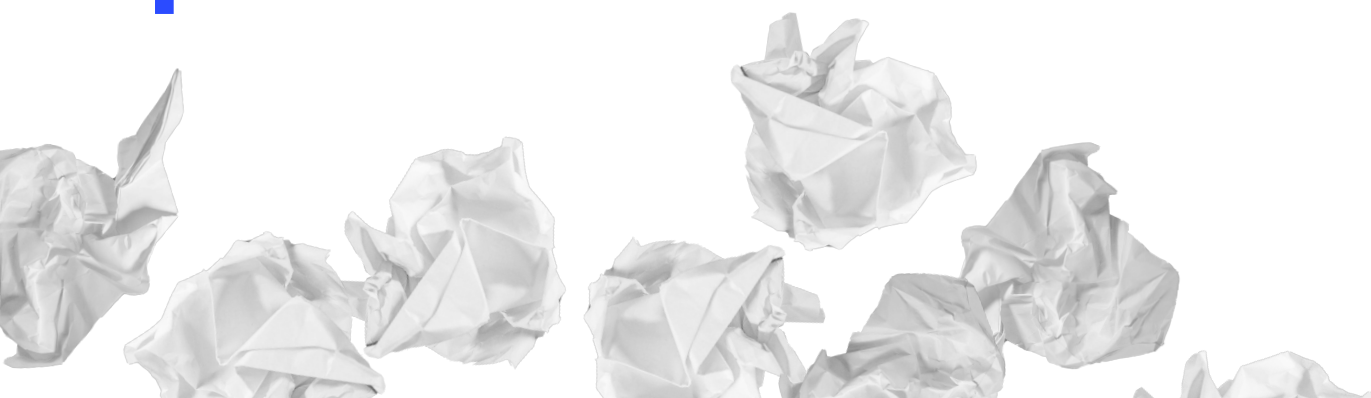

## The Risks of Poor Communication

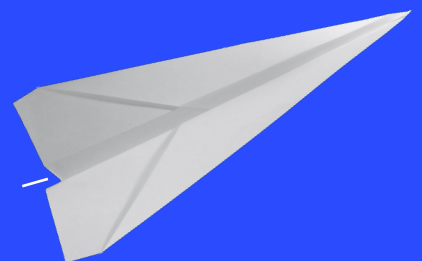

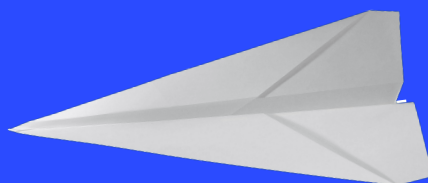

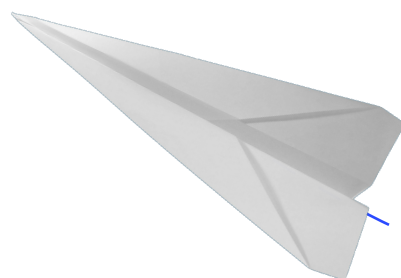
